Tenebrae means darkness and is a portion of the Liturgy of the Hours which looks forward to the celebration of Holy Thursday and the Easter Triduum. The beautiful ceremony includes psalms, 3 lamentations of Jeremiah sung by a soloist, and the gradual extinguishing of candles during the course of the night. The darkening of the Church against a Resurrection Candle is a beautiful way to begin the Triduum of Holy Week.
